About The Dr. Wu Lien-Teh Society, Penang

Dr. Wu Lien-Teh, born in Penang, Malaysia, in 1879 and educated at the Penang Free School, was one of the few recipients of the prestigious Queen's Scholarship to study medicine at the University of Cambridge. He was credited as "the plague fighter" who saved thousands of lives in north-eastern China in the early part of the 20th Century when an outbreak of a serious pneumonic epidemic was successfully halted by Dr. Wu's new scientific approach to prevent the spreading of the killer disease. Dr. Wu died in Penang in 1960. Taman Wu Lien-Teh near the Penang Free School, is named to honour him. The **Dr. Wu Lien-Teh Society** was set-up to conduct research and support activities that promote the legacy of Dr. Wu Lien-Teh. It aims to organize lectures, workshops and conferences related to the work of Dr. Wu Lien-Teh and especially those relating to public health. The Society will also hold commemorative events on 10th March every year in conjunction with his birthday anniversary to remember this son of Penang whose great sacrifice, principles and philosophies have survived the times and touched millions of lives.
